

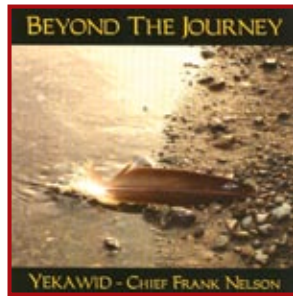

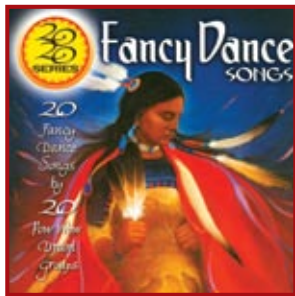
Title: **Art Napoleon - Siskabush Tales**

Siskabush is a cree/english pidgen word meaning those who hang out in the woods to do their hard drinking (and storytelling...). This disc is quite alt-country-rock flavored--Blackie & the Rodeo Kings, Fred Eaglesmith with a touch of Tom Cochrane--all from a northern rez boy's perspective of course.



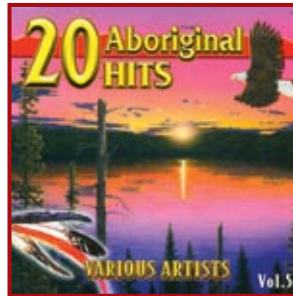
Title: **Chief Frank Nelson - Beyond the Journey**

Chief Frank has become an historian and composer for his tribe. He has been instrumental from the beginning of being fully involved in Tribal Journeys, and has so far, along with several good Teams to have coordinated seven Journeys. The songs he has acquired over the years has been inspired by his travels on his canoes, Dzunugungis and Lewagila.



Title: **Fancy Dance Songs**

The fancy dance itself requires high stepping, twirling movements. Shawl dancers represent the butterfly, which is why the dancer is supposed to move her arms with her shawl draped over them in movements representative of the fluttering of a butterfly. Traditions in the west say that the women's shawl dancers are similar to the men's grass dancers in that they represent a warrior's dance.



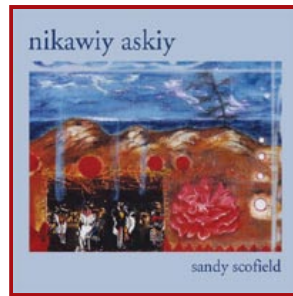
Title: **20 Aboriginal Hits**

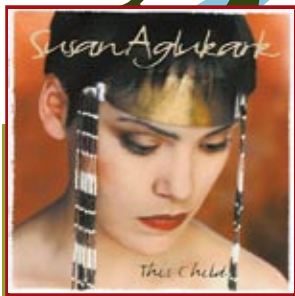
Title: **Spirit of the Nations**

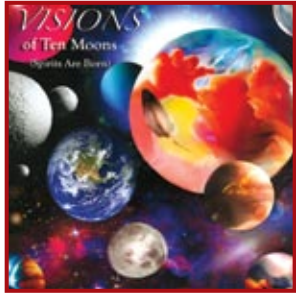
Title: **Art Napoleon - Miyoskamin**

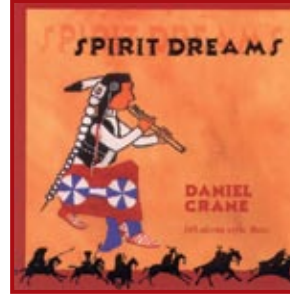
Title: **Chief Frank Nelson - Spirit of our Ancestors**

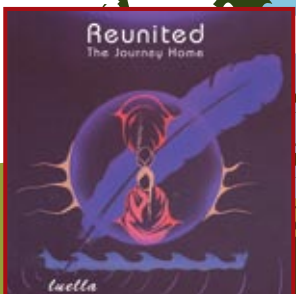
Title: **Rising from the Ashes**

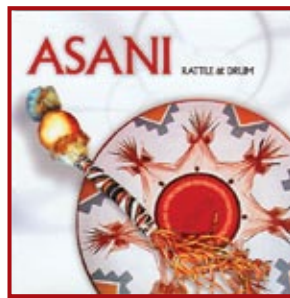

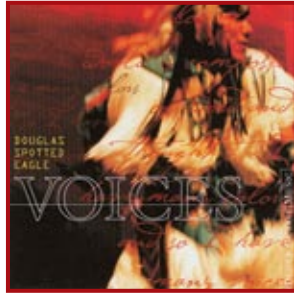
Title: **Round Dance Songs**

The Round Dance creates a simple and fun activity that brings both cultures together for positive interaction. In celebrating this circle of life, it is no co-incidence that the structure of all Pow Wows is a circle, a dance that gives men and women a chance to fall in love, as opposed to the thunder of a pow wow drum, round dance music is soft, slow and gentle vocals are very tender on the album.



Title: **Asani - Rattle & Drum**

Asani, a contemporary a cappella Aboriginal women's trio from Canada, officially formed in April 1997. Taken from the Cree word "asiniy", which means "rock, the group's name was chosen because the enduring strength of rock is reflected in the lives and music of each of its members. Title: **Douglas Spotted Eagle - Voices**

on his 14th solo recording, during the making of which his teenage son died, Spotted Eagle has again channeled his considerable loss into a work unlike any other. 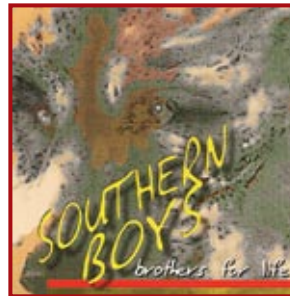
Title: **Robbie Robertson - Music for Native Americans**

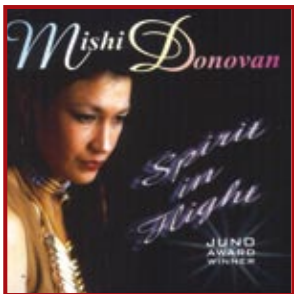
Title: **Laureen Rama - Drums for the Shaman**

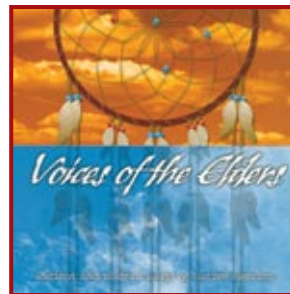
Title: **Southern Boys - Brothers for Life**

Title: **Voices of Elders**

Title: **Buffy Sainte-Marie - Up Where we Belong**

\*Born on a Cree reservation in Qu'Appelle Valley, Saskatchewan, Buffy Sainte-Marie was adopted and raised in Maine and Massachusetts. She received a Ph.D. in Fine Art from the University of Massachusetts. "Up Where We Belong" is a song from the 1982 film An Officer and a Gentleman. The song won Buffy an Academy Award for Best Original Song



Title: **Sacred Spirit**

Like its predecessor, the collection mixes chant and song with dance beats and electronic instrumentation. While tracks such as "Dela Dela" and "Yane-Heja-Hee" meld these elements most effectively, the overall effect of the synthesized sound is heavily over the top and distracting from the gentle melodies and heartfelt cries of Native music at its best.
